Subject: Request from Belvedere-Tiburon Joint Recreation to hold a special event at Belvedere Community Park, including the use of amplified sound

Recommended Motion/Item Description

Approve request for use of amplified music during the Family Fun Day event.

Background

This item is a request from Belvedere-Tiburon Joint Recreation (BTJR) to hold a Family Fun Day special event at Community Park on April 30, 2016, from 11:00 AM – 3:00 PM. According to the submitted special event permit application, BTJR intends to use amplified sound during the event. Amplified music is not permitted per Restriction #2 listed on the first page of the special event permit application (Attachment 1). Staff requests direction from the City Council as to whether the use of amplified music for this public event would be acceptable. The remaining details of the event, such as parking, road closures, and cleanup, can be addressed at the staff level to ensure as minimal impact to neighboring residents as possible.

A courtesy notice about the proposed use of amplified sound during the Family Fun Day event was mailed to residences directly uphill of Community Park, up to Bayview Avenue, who were anticipated to experience the greatest impact from the amplified noise. Residents were invited to comment on the proposed event and raise any concerns they may have. As of the publication of this report, no comments have been received.

Recommendation

Approve request for use of amplified music during the Family Fun Day event.
