20.7.1 POLICE POLICY MANUAL

The Belvedere Police Department (BPD) Policy Manual is incorporated into the Administrative Policy Manual of the City of Belvedere by reference. Changes to the Belvedere Police Policy Manual recommended by the City’s public safety risk management consultant (Lexipol) and approved by the Chief of Police shall be implemented on an interim basis and reported to the City Council concurrent with the next quarterly report by the Chief of Police to City Council. Such changes will, in the ordinary course of business, be ratified by Council at that meeting. In the event that Council expresses significant concern about any BPD policy or change thereto, the Mayor may establish an ad hoc committee to consult with the Chief of Police and report back to the full Council with its recommendation. The BPD will continue to implement any pending changes until such report is made and Council makes a final decision on the matter.
